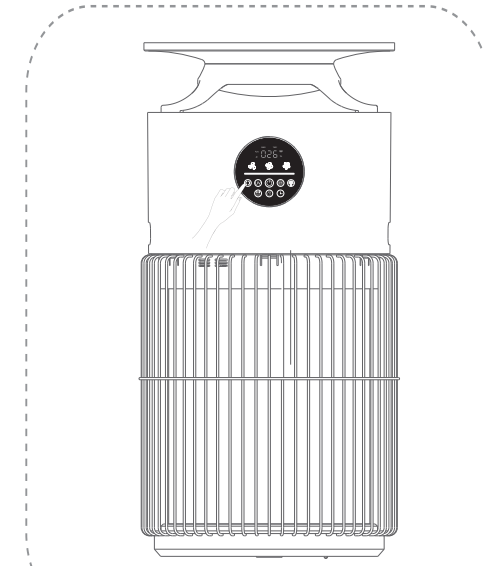
Control Panel Overview



Use the air purifier

- Power on/off**
1.Put the plug of the purifier in a power socket.
2.Press the power button to turn on the purifier; the purifier starts on the Auto mode by default.
3.Press the power button to turn off the air purifier
- Mode**
1.Tap the mode button to switch from Auto mode, Sleep Mode, low, medium, high fan speeds
2.Auto mode--the purifier will automatically switch fan speed and air purify rate according to the air quality level
3.Sleep mode--the purifier will operate ultra-low noise for a comfortable sleeping environment
- UV Disinfection**
1.Tap to turn on/off the UV light.

- Air Ionizer**
Tap to turn on/off the Air Ionizer. Ion particles have a positive or negative charge that attach to airborne particles, making them easier to be captured by the filtration system
- Filter life display**
Tap to display how many days left to replace the filter;
The will turn orange when filter lifespan ≤ 10 days;
The will turn red when filter lifespan ≤ 3 days;
The will red flashed when filter lifespan > 0 days
- Filter life reset**
Long tap for 5 seconds to reset the filter life when replace a new filter
- Child lock**
Tap and hold the child lock button for 3 seconds to activate/de-activate the child lock. When the child lock is on, all the other buttons are not responsive
- Timer**
Tap the timer button to choose the number of hours you want the purifier to operate. The timer is available in 1H-12H.
Tap and hold the timer button for 3 second to cancel timer setting
- Wifi Reset**
Press and hold the Mode icon for 5 seconds. Once you hear a beep, and the WiFi indicator flashes, the purifier's wifi has been reset successfully

APP Connection

- Method 1**
Download the Smart Life app from App store or mobile app stores.
- Method 2**
Scan the below QR to download Smart Life app
- 1.Install the "Smart Life" App**
Tap the "Get" button to install the app.
- 2.Open the Tuya app and choose to create a new account or log in directly**
Tap the "Log In" button to log in.
- 3.Make sure the phone has the Wi-Fi connection and turn on the Bluetooth on your phone. Then click the "+" sign in the upper right corner to add the device**
- 4.Turn on the air purifier, and press and hold the Mode icon for 5 seconds. Once you hear a beep, and the WiFi indicator flashes, the purifier's wifi has been reset successfully**

Air quality real time monitoring

- The machine is equipped with a high-precision particle sensor. After starting the machine, it automatically checks the content of particles in the air near the machine. At the same time, it is displayed by the light in the machine after the chip is converted.
- There are 4 colors of air quality indicator, which are green, blue, yellow and red. Green means that the harmful gas content in the air is very low (air quality is excellent), blue means less harmful air in the air (air quality is good), and yellow means that the harmful gas content in the air has not reach to standard (air quality "Medium"), red means harmful gases in the air excessive content (poor air quality)

Replace the filter

- Switch off the purifier and unplug it from the wall outlet
- Use both hand to press and pull up the main body, to open the filter compartment
- Remove the old filter
- Remove the new filter from its packaging
- Put the new filter into the air purifier
- Find the positioning point and press to lock the filter compartment
- Plug the adaptor and switch on the purifier
- Press the filter reset button for 5 second to reset the filter lifespan

Warning

- Turn off and unplug the purifier before moving it.
- The purifier cannot turn on when the fan grille and the filter compartment cover are not installed properly.
- Maintain a distance of at least 20 cm between the air inlets and walls or other objects.
- Frequently remove dust, hair, and other particles from the outer mesh screen of the filter, so as to reduce the chance of bacteria growth.
- Remove dust, hair and particles from the purifier's air inlets to prevent a reduction of air intake.
- Cover the air outlet to prevent dust, hair, and other particles from falling in when the purifier is left unused for a long time.
- To avoid fire, electric shocks, or other damage, use the power cord and electrical outlet as instructed below:
 - Do not excessively pull, twist or bend the power cord, as this may expose or break the cord's core.
 - The power cord must be plugged into a suitable electrical outlet.
 - Use the power cord that was provided with the purifier, do not use any third party power cords.
 - Always unplug the purifier before carrying out maintenance to or moving the air purifier.
 - When the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced with a genuine power cord purchased from the manufacturer or after-sales service department.
- Immediately stop using the purifier when it makes unusual sounds, gives off bad odors, overheats, or its fan rotates irregularly.
- Do not stick your fingers or foreign objects into the protective parts, movable parts, air inlets, or air outlets.
- Keep objects such as hairs or fabrics away from the purifier to avoid blocking the air inlets or air outlets.
- Do not sit on, lean on or tilt the purifier.
- When using in conjunction with gas-fueled appliances (such as gas stoves, gas heaters), please ventilate sufficiently to avoid carbon monoxide poisoning.
- Do not pour liquids, nor throw powders or other small substances into the purifier's air outlet.
- Do not use the purifier in the following circumstances, as they may result in electric shocks, fire, or other damage:
 - Near open flames, such as candles, incense burners, stoves, fireplaces, cigarettes, firecrackers, lighters, multipurpose torches, candle lighters, or fire pans.
 - Near appliances that generate high temperatures, such as electric heaters, fan heaters, electric foot warmers, electric stoves, electric irons.
 - Make sure no inflammable objects get into the purifier.
 - In unstable locations where the purifier can easily fall over.
 - In environments that are extremely hot, humid, or damp, such as bathrooms.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

Clean and Care

- Clean the Purifier Housing
Clean at least once a month with a clean, dry, soft cloth. More frequent cleaning may be required depending on environmental conditions.
- Clean the Filter
It's recommended to clean the filter once a month by lightly brushing off any visible dust or dirt (take care to avoid disturbing the delicate network of interior fibers).
- Notes: Check and replace the filter when the filter indicator lights red flashes.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Solution
The filter indicator stays flashes red.	Check and replace the filter.
The filter indicator is still flashed red after replacing the air filter.	Tap and hold the filter reset button for 5 seconds to reset the filter indicator. The filter indicator will go out.
Poor air purification.	Tap the fan speed button to increase fan speed.
A strange smell comes from the purifier.	It's normal to produce a plastic smell when you use the appliance for the first few times. Clean or replace the filter if the air purifier has been frequently used for a period of time. If the appliance produces a smell of burning, please unplug the device and immediately contact customer service.
The child lock button light flashes.	If the child lock is activated, the child lock button light will flash when you tap any other button.
